HISTORICAL PREFACE

After 100 very frustrating years, the SHELDONs will be able to obtain copies of the now-printed "Sheldon Magazine, 1857, "Unprinted" Vol.V". Rev. Henry Olcott SHELDON stated in his preface to Vol.IV and on the last line of page 86 that one more volume for a total of 280 pages would be printed. Including title pages, 242 pages are visible, they being numbered in duplicate from 1 to 113.

He also mentioned that he then planned a revised complete genealogy "of not less than 480 pages". His type and property were lost during the Civil War. About 1882, he sent out a printed postal card from Oberlin, Ohio asking for revised data. He said that he had 17,000 names obtained by over 3000 letters and years of travel. The NEH&G Register, Jan. 1883, 37:90 printed the same announcement and that "this work will soon be put to press". He had died two weeks before, aged 83 years, and his obituary appeared in the next issue.

In the Library of the Presbyterian Church in the U.S. of A. in Philadelphia among some 8000 cataloged letters written to S#4445 Rev. Sheldon JACKSON, the famous missionary and U.S. Agent to Alaska, will be found many pleas to him, dated from 1893 to 1906, requesting the manuscript which he had obtained from Rev. H.O. SHELDON so that they could print it.

Apparently it was passed on in 1905 to S#4384 U.S. Senator Philetus Porter SHELDON, owner of the Jamestown (N.Y.) Post, for publishing. Then it disappeared.

After many years of search thruout the U.S. by this Editor, it was found nearby in Medina, N.Y. in 1955 by your Genealogical Committee Chairman in the possession of S#9521x1 John Layton SHELDON, Jr., an attorney who had been publisher of the Lockport (N.Y.) Journal. He stated that he had obtained it about 1906 from Jamestown in a parcels post package after requesting it, but that nothing had been printed.

This invaluable manuscript, started 130 years ago, consists of about 700 pages of 9"x14" rag ledger folio beautifully written and bound in morocco. It had been rewritten and revised 5 times. The third being the Sheldon Magazine, 1857 shows that there are over 1500 typographicals in the printed copies.

Vol.V is a revised edition of the unprinted part with additional data taken from the card files to fill in the blank spaces with later data plus 16 pages of indexes.

One folio, pages 122r to 140r, is still missing and will be printed as Vol.VI if and when it is found.

NOTES: This Index gives access to new and previously unprinted manuscript data which will be of value to genealogists or those searching for their last connection to the SHELDON-lineage data, as well as to the many descendants of female-SHELDONs carried in the "Sheldon Magazine, 1857". Please insert this at p.113 of your copy.

Since the husbands and 1850-residence of female-SHELDONs were usually shown on the line where these females first appeared, as well as in the printed "Index to Names of Men who married into the Sheldon Family" which gave the S# (indicating the page and line including the unprinted Vol.V), this new Index plus a proposed "Index of Mothers married to SHELDONs as shown in the Sheldon Magazine, 1857, Volumes I to IV", should make readily available the vast store of genealogical data compiled by S#5124 Rev.H.O.SHELDON.

Much SHELDON data is to be noted in other more recent genealogies. Such should be reported by filling out the 5"x3" Sheldon Family Data Cards and adding the family S# x - , if it is known. See the card, "Numbering System for Sheldon Magazine, 1857 & EXTENSION". Full reference to the source should be given at bottom of card.

A Reprint of the very scarce and valuable "Sheldon Magazine, 1857" with corrections of the many typographical errors as shown by the long-lost original manuscript will be made available for the 1957 anniversary.

INDEX of MOTHERS married to SHELDONS

(Viz., daughters-in-law of last-printed family-heads.)

Their 1850 residence was usually given on the line where their husband, the male-SHELDON, first appeared in print, as well as his year of birth, the page-reference to Vol. V, and their family S#, hence all but their children.

NUMBERING SYSTEM As described in the Original Preface of 1855 which is reprinted in the section of Indexes, the S#s in Vol. V indicate the page and line where the SHELDON head-of-family can be found in Vols. I to IV as a child along with his parents and other data including a cross-reference to Vol. V. As an example, S#5297 will be found on page 53 on the 47th line of the right-hand page, since they are numbered in duplicate with 50 lines to a page. There were 11,250 S#s for that many possible families as of 1855. No higher S# will be used.

Starting with the S# of the last ancestor shown in Vols. I to IV, all of his descendants will always take that family S# plus a line-of descent or extension number to be shown as S# x. The extension # or x - part is merely the order of birth in each following generation, hence everybody should be able to supply 3 or 4 of their own x - - and future generations can do likewise, thus:

- S#5297x1 is the first unlisted child; and the 10th is S#5297x10
- If full order of birth in a generation is unknown, use S#5297x - -2-1
- If last printed ancestor is unknown, leave blank spaces S# ___ x - -2-1

This numbering system starts with Vol. V and should be used in all Extensions, on Sheldon Family Data Cards in the places provided, wherever any SHELDON is mentioned including signatures to letters.

Since many have the same name, this will facilitate searching and filing of the cards which are arranged by S# x - -. Most of the data with indexes has now been printed up to 1850 to help you find your ancestry.

If any SHELDON descendant cannot find his family S#, it will be supplied by the Genealogical Committee on receipt of a set of Sheldon Family Data Cards, one for each generation at least back to 1850, unless more recent data on the line is available in the card files. See sample.

Full names and the places with all dates as well as the lineage as far as possible are needed for proof. Add a † (plus) after the x - before the given names of each child, on the back of the card, who is known to have had a child, thus indicating that a card should be made for that family.

SHELDON MAGAZINE EXTENSIONS These are printed booklets giving the genealogical record of any one SHELDON family line starting with the last ancestor shown in the Sheldon Magazine, 1857, Vols. I to V.

The great historian of Deerfield, Mass., S#2981 George SHELDON (1818-1916), maintained thruout his 98 years of life that he could not print any family's data until they had written it down in a logical form. Since the vast work of Rev. H.O. SHELDON of 1857, a number of manuscripts have been written (many of which have been noted herein), but only a few are known to have been printed until recently. He did all of the work so perhaps the failure of the SHELDONs was due to the fact that he did not teach the next generation to carry on.

Now, hundreds of SHELDONs in the various family lines are busily trying to bring the record up to date using what has been called the "Sheldon System" — a series of steps in easy stages by which anyone can readily produce an Extension. They become the local family genealogist and show others how to do likewise in the future.

The data must be written on cards — one per family — so that each addition can be arranged in proper order or alphabetized for making indexes, as well as to permit sending them to others for their data. Three or four sets are usually made including a file set and a copy for the Association's master file of SHELDONs. A sample of the exact form in which the cards should be written is shown on the next page. Spaces should be left for unknown or future data and nothing else placed on that line. To avoid confusion with middle names and that of places, all SURNAMES must be printed in CAPITALS, as indicated in this volume.

Since the Sheldon Magazine gives only the minimum of data as an outline due to space limitations, an effort should be made to get full data from all sources for the card of the first ancestor shown and all of his descendants. A mimeoed blank Title Card can be obtained from the author.

Any method of printing is satisfactory — mimeo, photo-offset or linotype as shown by these sample volumes. Linotype was used for the Index and the metal slugs were alphabetized to save writing a card for each name. Enough should be printed so that copies can be traded with others.

Since the plan is to bind copies of all Sheldon Magazine Extensions printed by the various SHELDONs into books for deposit in genealogical libraries, they should all be printed on 8½"x11" part-rag paper with 4 unnumbered pages to a sheet. They will be put in the order of S# x.

A full title page should be included in the form of sample mimeoed blank Title Page Card which is available.

However, the cover of the booklet of not more than 24 to 28# paper may be dressed up by reproducing on it the design shown at the left. A 4½"x7" full-scale copy of it for photo-offsetting will be given to whoever is ready to print an Extension.

It is the design of S#9759x7-1 Edward Mark SHELDON of San Francisco who by the use of Sheldon Family Data Cards produced the first perfect example of a Sheldon Magazine Extension with Indexes, in July 1955. Instructions were sent to him by mail.

The last step should be the production of a quantity of 5"x3" catalog cards describing and analyzing the booklet for use when donating a copy to a library and other record purposes. A mimeoed sample is available. S#5297x6-2 Carew SHELDON, Editor.
