Hannah, daughter of John and Ann Sheldon, b 12 Feb. 1804, bapt. 4 March.  
Samuel, son of John and Ann Sheldon, b. 17 July 1805, bapt. Sept. 15.  
Louisa, daughter of John and Ann Sheldon, b. 18 Sept. 1806, bapt. 9 Jan. 1807  
Thos., son of John and Ann Sheldon, b. 8 Nov. 1807, bapt. 30 Dec.  
Ann, daughter of John and Ann Sheldon, born 16 Sept. 1809, bapt. 5 Jan. 1810.  
Mary Ann, daughter of John and Ann Sheldon, b. 26 April 1811, bapt. 14 August, following.  
Abigail, daughter of John and Ann Sheldon, born 7 Oct. 1812, bapt. 10 Feb. 1813.  
Charles, son of John and Ann Sheldon, b. 3 Feb. 1814, bapt. 16 Feb. 1814, christened, 20  
March 1814.

Ann Sheldon, my dear wife, dyed 17 March 1814, aged 35 years.

Ann, dyed 28 June 1814, aged 4 years, and 9 months.

Abigail, dyed, 29 June 1813.

Thomas, d. 10 April 1826, aged 18 yrs, 4 mos, and 3 weeks.

Samuel, d. 12 May 1831, aged 25 years, and 10 mos.

John Sheldon, Father of annexed family died, aged 65 years and eight months, 4 March 1834.

Louisa, daughter of John and Ann Sheldon, d. 5 Nov. 1834, aged 28 yrs. and 7 wks.

John, eldest son of John and Ann Sheldon, d. 23 Feb. 1840, aged 37 yrs.

Written on a small slip of paper and pasted in Bible was found the following entry: "Edward  
Scarisbricke, anno domini 1595. Henrie Scarisbricke, departed this life 14th day of October  
anno domini 1608 and Edward Scarisbricke son of the said Henrie, was borne anno domini  
1600."

Written on inside of cover: Nov. 22, 1757. John Sheldon, bought this Book of Mr. Will<sup>m</sup>  
Warde, of Sheffield, Yorkshire.

(Note: It appears that the John Sheldon, above who bought the Bible in 1757, was no doubt the  
father of the John Sheldon in the above record who died in 1834, aged 65, therefore born  
in 1769) OR circa . .

Oxford Bible, printed by Thomas Basket, printer to the university in 1756.

MARTIN

Edward Paulin Martin, died in Spanish Honduras, 11 July 1912, of Typhoid, brought home  
and buried in Abington, Cemetery.

Bible printed in 1575, 6th edition of Bishop's Bible.

Maria Longman, b. 21 Aug. 1819.

Jos. Thacker, d. 26 March 1820.

John Longman, b. 22 Dec. 1821, chr. at Tipton 15 Jan 1822.

Edith Ballard, d. 10 Mar. 1822.

Joseph Longman, b. 26 Dec. 1823, d. 18 (or 28?) Nov. 1825.

Edwin & Noner Longman, b. 9 (or 19) Oct. 1826.

Edwin Longman, d. 10 Jany. 1832, aged 5 yrs, 2 mo.

Emah Longman, b. 19 Aug. 1830 (or 1831), chr. in Tipton Church, by Mr. Howell, Rector.

Ann Longman, d. 16 Aug. 1832, aged 39.

John Longman. d. 2 Dec. 1834, aged 47.

George Longman, b. 21 May 1854, Mary Ann Longman, wife of above b. 14 Dec. 1854, d. 6 Dec.

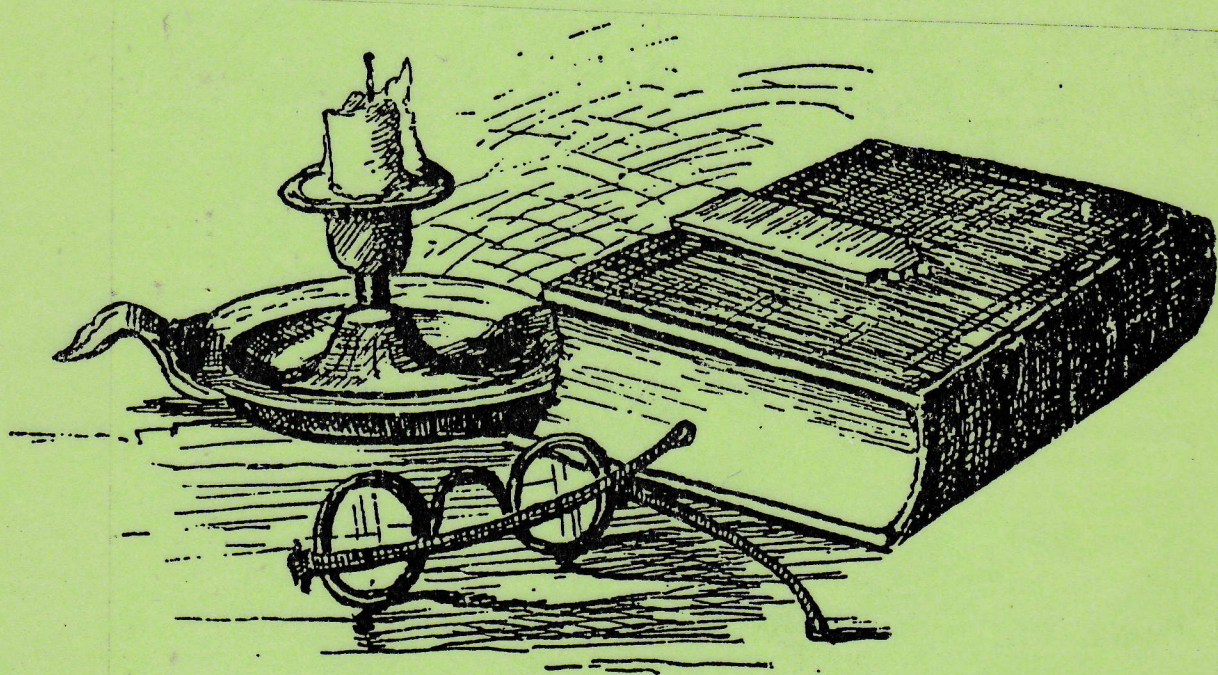
